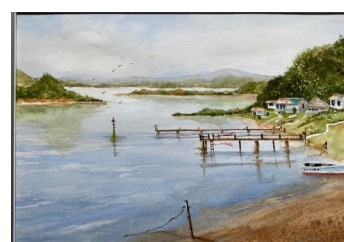
ART LESSONS

Classes with Lynne Lucas in Watercolour at Tinkat Alley - UPDATE

Lynne's classes have been changed to 10 lessons on **Mondays - 7, 14, 21 & 28 March; 11, 18, 25 April; 9, 16 & 23 May** from 1.00 to 4.00pm. Cost is \$25 per lesson - you can come for as many classes as you wish but please book. Students need to bring their own materials (materials can be purchased at the studio):

1 full sheet of Watercolour paper 300gs smooth or medium; Practice pieces of W/C paper 300gms; Hb pencil, eraser, drawing paper; Watercolour paints; Palette; w/c brushes; pictures of sailing boats, small tenders, the lake, skies etc (some will be provided); a board or sheet of flute board from Bunning's and masking tape.

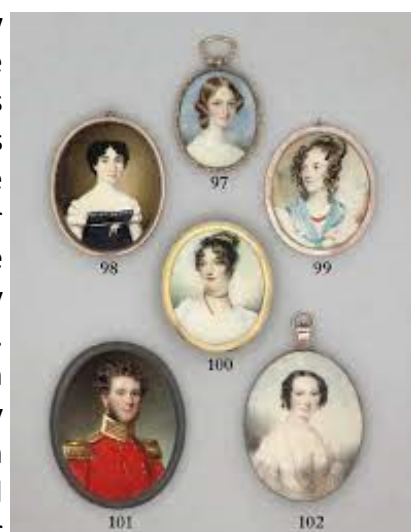

AMAZING TALENT - Sarah Biffin



Sarah Biffin was a 19th century painter famous for her impeccable miniature paintings, realistic artworks whose practically microscopic details were lauded as being some of the best in technique and style of her time. She spent many years in the circus until she gained wealthy patrons, including Queen Victoria. Sarah also happened to have been born without legs or arms - which only made her obvious talents that much more incredible. Her skills were hard won and surpassed many of her



contemporaries, regardless of her physical differences, and she is remembered as one of the best miniaturist painters of her time.

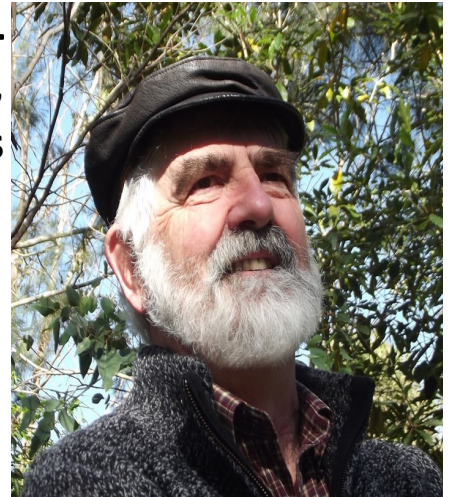
