- 1/2" Taklon flat brush or similar
- A3 or A4 canvas board purchase at 2dollar or art shops
- Apply 2 coats of Acylic Titanium White before workshop
- Clean Kitchen sponge
- Chux or clean cloths
- Scissors (small curved fine points) either embroidery or cuticle scissors
- Blue Tack
- Small dish for water and palette
- Don't forget your drop cloth, easel and LUNCH


