



DENISE LOMBARD, Artist

In 2001, for their safety, Denise and her husband moved from South Africa to Australia. To appreciate their adopted country they decided to explore this vast continent, especially the "Outback" desert encompassing the major area of their new home. The diversity, colours, textures, light and mood of the landscape inspired Denise to renew her passion with painting. Over the years, working as a physiotherapist, wife and mother, she attended many art courses and lately online classes.

During Covid and lock down, Denise's art practice underwent a radical change. Unable to get to art supplies she took old paintings and re-worked them with material found in her garden and home. This then progressed to new work using paints, bark, pebbles and anything to give the effect she wanted, glued on with wood glue and creating three dimensional work.

In her demonstration she will be showing the techniques used to create these effects. She will also be creating a small work from an abstract doodle using what you have at home. This is quick and fun and will be what we will do in the workshop.

List of Materials for your Workshop

Paper: A sheet of good quality watercolour paper, at least 200 gsm - A4 size or larger, taped all around on a board with the rough side up for working on.

Medium: Any inks and felt tip pens

Essentials: Paper glue with an old brush for application, paper towel, rags, cover for the table, container for water, hairdryer if you have one to share.



No need to bring any bark etc as Denise will provide these materials. If you are a quick worker bring another piece of paper.



We will be painting on fabric! You need to purchase either an apron, cushion cover, calico bag or a piece of cotton fabric in a colour of your choice that can be made into something later such as a table runner. Spotlight or the Reject stop sell some of the items and Kmart sell white t-shirts.




