Suggested choices are the following on cotton fabric:-

- Apron
- Cushion Cover
- Calico Bag
- T-Shirt
- Piece of plain cotton, colour of your choice, to make something later i.e. table runner.

Kathryn will be doing a selection (samples attached to the email) of Christmas themes such as poinsettias, Christmas bush, decorations and ribbons, etc. However, you are welcome to make your own design. Kathryn will also make up some patterns.

Materials Required:

- A piece of wood or Perspex big enough to put under fabric, a wooden placemat or plastic chopping board will do, if doing a bag it needs to fit inside so fabric is separated (Kathryn will have a few spare boards with her).
- Glad wrap and sticky tape or masking tape to cover the board. We can't put fabric straight onto the table as it may stick to it and you need a flat hard surface underneath to paint
- A selection of brushes, round and flat.
- Acrylic paint.
- Fabric medium she uses Jo Sonja but there will be bottles to share.
- Table cloth, water jar, pallet etc
- A few blow dryers would be handy.
